Bryan Jordan and Jeff Beaty, who have operated the VistaWorks Internet marketing company in Buena Vista for nine years, are president and vice president of Advantage Computer Solutions, which was purchased from Chris Montera of Buena Vista.

The company provides repair service for businesses as well as residential customers. The staff will go to homes and businesses or peo-

ple can bring in equipment. They can diagnose and fix any computer- or networking-related problems, Jordan said.

Advantage Computers will provide training and consult with people about purchasing a computer, Jordan said.

The company also provides outsourcing for IT (information technology) services.

"A lot of people need IT services but don't want to have a fulltime employee," he said.

For those wanting to get Internet service, Jordan said, "We don't provide it, but we can facilitate it - we can tell them who we trust."

For a flat fee the staff can diagnose and check a comput-

er.

"We try to work with people to make sure they get what they need at the right cost and the least expense to them," Jordan said.

One of the first things done when a computer is brought in is a check for "malware" and viruses.

Getting rid of those solves a lot of the problems someone may be having with a computer, he said.
